Following her work as a legal consultant, Dr. Adolphe obtained her doctorate in canon law. Dr. Adolphe is currently an associate professor of law at Ave Maria Law School in Ann Arbor, Michigan where she teaches International Law, Human Rights, Family Law and Canon Law.
